As If Books & Games - Submission Guidelines for Authors

1. Document Setup

- Page Size: Use standard size (8.5 x 11").
- Margins: Set all margins to 1 inch.
- Font: Use a standard font like Times New Roman, Arial, or Calibri in 12-point size.

2. Text Formatting

- Paragraphs: You may choose to indent the first line of each paragraph by 0.5 inches OR add up to 1 line of vertical space beneath each paragraph. Do NOT do both.
- Alignment: Left align body text. Do not justify any text, unless positioning is part of the meaning being communicated.
- Tabular Data: While some data may need to be presented in tabular format (for game design manuals), the tables themselves should not be themed or decorated. If possible, please use *Tabs* to set your columns. If content length makes this impossible, make your tables dirtsimple and without décor.

3. Headings and Subheadings

- **Section Titles**: Use a larger font size (16-20 point) and bold. Center-align them.
- Chapter Titles: Use a larger font size (14-16 point) and bold. Left-align them.
- **Subheadings**: Simply bold or italicize the standard body font. Left-align them.

4. Lists and Bullet Points

- Use automated bullet points or numbered lists for clarity when necessary to present information. Do NOT add numbers or middots manually: we have to remove them.
- Maintain consistent formatting for all lists (e.g., same bullet style, same indentation).

5. Page Numbers & Tables of Contents

• Not required. If you use page numbers, center them at the bottom of each page.

6. File Naming

- Name your file using the following format:
 AuthorLastName_Title_Version
 (e.g.: Smith TheGreatNovel V1.docx).
- For minor versioning, use dashes instead of periods.

(e.g.: Smith_TheGreatNovel_V1-2.docx).

Submission Process

- File Type: Ensure your manuscript is in one of these formats: TXT, DOC, DOCX, or ODT. Do not send PDF files.
- 2. **Final Review**: Before submitting, do a final read-through to catch any formatting inconsistencies or errors.
- Submission: Use the online submission form at https://todfoley.com/ OR email your manuscript as an attachment to tod@todfoley.com. If I'm not already expecting you, include a brief cover letter with your contact info and a summary of your manuscript.

Things Editors Like to See

- Be Clear and Concise: Ensure that your writing is clear, and avoid unnecessary jargon.
- **Use Comments**: If any specific sections need special attention, use the comment feature to highlight these areas
- Follow Industry Standards: Familiarize yourself with common publishing standards and practices to improve your manuscript's quality.
